Our Graduate Programmes

Man Group offers three streams of graduate programme – the business, quantitative and technology programmes. Each comprises of 6-month rotations in relevant business areas in London (UK), Pfäffikon (Switzerland) and Chicago/New York(US). The programmes are 19 months in duration, with the exception of those on the Business programme who join the Finance team who will be on the programme for 3 years during their sponsorship to qualify for CIMA.

The rotational nature of the programmes mean that you gain exposure that is unparalleled in our business. Your knowledge of investment management and of Man and your skills will develop and grow through each rotation. In some ways however, it is like starting a new job every six months, with all of the challenge, demand and learning that encompasses. Our programmes begin with a month-long induction which equips you with the core skills and knowledge you need to start your role. From there, you will undertake any training that is needed for your rotations. Our graduates are also expected to study for a professional qualification (e.g. CFA, IMC), which will be decided with you dependent on your programme and your future ambitions. Those who join the Finance team must study for and qualify in the CIMA Professional Qualification.

No two graduates follow the same path at Man Group. We work with you to agree the best rotations for your development and for our business.

Business Programme

The Business Programme is designed to develop graduates with breadth and depth of experience in our core business areas and the operational and client service teams that support them. Graduates can expect to develop analytical, research and project management skills in areas such as Finance, Investment Services and Client Reporting, Risk, Product Management, Due Diligence, Client Services and E-Commerce. Each graduate on the programme is hosted by a business area which they will rotate in at least once and return to at the end of the programme. Business Programme graduates will typically study for the CFA qualification. Those based in the Finance team are required to study for CIMA.

Technology Programme

Our Technology Programme offers a fantastic opportunity to gain an in-depth exposure to the component parts of a large technology team. The programme comprises of rotations through key departments in London and Switzerland, such as AHL Technology, E-Commerce, Software Design & Development, Infrastructure or Engineering teams. These rotations will expose the successful graduates to elements of development, project management, business analysis, network support and the everyday challenges faced within a commercial technology department.

Quantitative Programme

Our quantitative programme offers in-depth exposure to the forefront of the alternative investment industry, through varied experiences across areas such as Portfolio Construction, Product Structuring, Research, Risk Management and Quantitative Analysis. This will enable you to develop your research and quantitative skills, whilst increasing your knowledge of investment management and the hedge fund industry.
